## HIGHLIGHTS

- Fire Indices are High to Extreme for the eastern portion of Alaska. Officials ask that you make sure campfires are completely out and that you adhere to burn permit regulations. Should burning take place please be careful, make sure tools and water are available, do not leave fires unattended, and properly dispose of smoking materials. To obtain permitted burning information call your local Alaska Division of Forestry office or visit their website at: <http://www.dnr.state.ak.us/forestry/burn>.
- Open fires are prohibited in the developed areas of Denali National Park. For more information call (907) 683-2294 or visit [www.nps.gov/dena](http://www.nps.gov/dena).
- Two additional CL-215 medium water-scooping aircraft are expected to arrive in Fairbanks this evening, from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, to join the Alaska Fire Service fleet of firefighting aircraft.
- Currently 15 fires are active in Alaska. Four of the fires are staffed and the rest are in monitor status. So far this year the Alaska Interagency Coordination Center (AICC) reports 180 fires statewide have burned nearly 118,415 acres statewide. The AICC coordinates fire management resources for the BLM Alaska Fire Service, the Alaska Division of Forestry and the U.S. Forest Service.
