## HIGHLIGHTS

- There have been a total of 71 fires reported this year. All fires have been human caused. Total acreage burned is over 1,582 acres
- A prescribed burn is underway at Fort Richardson. The burn was ignited by firefighters on the ground. Approximately 1,000 acres are scheduled to be ignited. There may be some smoke from the fires that may affect the Anchorage Area.
- Four smokejumpers are on standby for today.
- Please remember to get a burning permit from the Alaska Department of Forestry if you plan to include fire in your spring cleanup.
