HIGHLIGHTS

- There have been a total of 79 fires reported this year. All but one fire have been human caused. Total acreage burned is over 1,756 acres. There are 8 active fires which are being monitored; 5 of these fires are located on military lands.
- One fire near McGrath may have been lightning caused and the acreage burned was approximately 50 acres.
- Multiple prescribed fires are being planned for May 11-12, 2007 (Weather permitting). The following areas are scheduled for prescribed burns: Oklahoma, Manchu (aerial ignition), Bolio and Texas Range (hand and aerial ignition) and Chena Lakes Overflow Area (hand ignition).
- There was one lightning strike recorded yesterday and it was near Anchorage. There has been only one strike recorded per day for the last three days.
