Applicants for Rookie Academy must:

- Fill out a Rookie Application and fax it to 907-356-5609.
- Have an IS-700.B & IS-100.C certificates (on-line classes) BEFORE being accepted to Rookie Academy.

 - FAX certificates to: 1-907-356-5609
 - Email certificates to: AFS_EFF@blm.gov
- Be cleared by the Fort Wainwright (Dept. of Defense) Security Screening process prior to acceptance.
- Have an ID card that is able to be scanned by Fort Wainwright security. ID cards must be REAL ID compliant by June 1, 2019 however, they do not need to be for the dates of this Rookie Academy.
 - State issued Driver's License
 - State issued ID Card
 - Tribal issued ID Cards (federally recognized tribes only)
 - US Passports or Passport Cards
 - Federally-issued Personal Identification Verification card
 - State Department Driver's License
 - Department of Homeland Security Trusted Traveler Cards
 - Veterans Health Identification Card
 - U.S. Permanent Resident Card
- Be at least 18 years of age or older prior to May 19, 2019.

Reminder: In order to become "qualified" to fight fire for the BLM (all Federal EFF/AD) you must first complete a medical exam, be medically cleared and pass the Work Capacity Test (Pack Test).

If accepted to the Rookie Academy, 100% attendance is mandatory. Travel and meals will be provided by Alaska Fire Service. Applications are available to anyone interested.
