


WIMS Help Sheet

Creating SIG Groups (from scratch or by copying)


1. Log in to WIMS at: <https://nap.nwcg.gov/NAP/>.
2. Once in WIMS, go to the **FastPath** block in the upper left and type in “**NSIG**” for creating a New SIG Group.
3. In the NSIG screen,
 - a. Enter a SIG Name- your choice and what you will want to remember it by
 - b. Select “**Setup**”

4. **Option 1 (from scratch):** A list will appear in which you can enter the 6-letter codes for all stations you wish to have in the SIG Group. Be sure to select “**Save**” when you are finished.

5. **Option 2 (copy someone else’s SIG):**
 - a. Select “**Copy**”. A new window will pop up.
 - b. You’ll need to know the user ID of the person who’s SIG you want to copy. Type it into the appropriate block and select “**Display**”.
 - c. Choose the SIG you want to copy, then confirm “**Copy**” on the next screen.

- d. You’ll get a little warning popup telling you that x number of stations will be copied to your SIG. Choose “**Ok**”.
 - e. After that window disappears, the station numbers should appear in your list. Select “**Save**”.
6. You can now use your SIG Group instead of individual station identifiers and complete all observations at once.
