Incident Requirements

- Safety of firefighters and the public
- COVID-19 Risk Mitigations
- Air Quality
- Coordination with stakeholders and agencies
- Public information distribution
- Address community concerns
- Smoke management and education
- Minimum Impact Suppression Tactics
- Location of camps and/or helispots
- Retardant/foam use
- Heavy equipment use/soils
- Invasive species
- Cultural resource site consultation/avoidance
- Anadromous fisheries
- Water withdrawal
- Wildlife habitat
- Threatened, endangered, or sensitive species
- Post-fire access to firelines
- Wilderness restrictions
- Fiscal responsibility and financial documentation

Course of Action

- Direct/Indirect Suppression Tactics
- Site Protection
- Use existing barriers to contain fire
- Monitor fire
- Plan for evacuation
- Implement area, road, or trail closures
- Collect new structure data for Known Sites Database
