

ISAP Foundational Pillars:

Ongoing risk-based conversations assess & track risk evolution throughout the incident

Consists of 4 Pillars:

1. Critical Values at Risk



- Specific threatened Critical Values are identified & rated by host Agency Administrator(s) to inform IMT actions.

2. Strategy & Strategic Actions

- Strategies are developed and divided into 2-5 Strategic Actions that address the unique incident needs.

3. Risks to Responders



- Six risk influencers of common denominator wildland fire mechanisms of injury are considered for each portion of the strategy.

4. Probability of Success



- Defining Success and understanding challenges and opportunities are a key component of informing the risk discussion.
