Incident Objectives

- Protect values at risk.
 - Villages
 - Communities
 - Allotments
 - Designated improvements
 - Structures
 - Timber
 - Habitat reduction or enhancement
 - Infrastructure
- Safety of firefighters and the public
- Public information distribution
- Smoke management and education
- Fire costs
- Plan for evacuation
- Coordination with stakeholders and agencies
- Allow fire to play natural role/fuels mitigation
- Community concerns

Incident Requirements

- Retardant/foam use
- Heavy equipment use/soils
- Minimum Impact Suppression Tactics
- Anadromous fisheries
- Access
- Air Quality
- Invasive species
- Water withdrawal
- Wildlife habitat
- Threatened or endangered species (or sensitive)
- Location of camps and/or helispots
- Non-structural cultural resource sites
- Wilderness restrictions

Course of Action

- Suppress fire at smallest acres
- Describe box inside which fire should be contained/controlled
- Mechanism for protection of structures and/or allotments
- Use existing barriers to contain fire
- Implement area, road, or trail closures
- Collect new structure data for Known Sites Database
- Monitor fire
