# Coffee Brief

## Date:

### Weather Summary

At this time, it looks like the center of the high remains over the state, though in a weaker form, through the weekend. Temperatures will remain a bit warm, while allowing a chance for waves with showers and thunderstorms to roll through late in the week and into the weekend. Though wetting rains may occur in the south, storms will be mostly dry in the north. Early next week may bring a more substantial pattern change, which will bring some cooler temperatures, a better chance for slightly wetter showers, and a better likelihood of clearing out some smoke!

Red Flag Warnings are active through Friday.

### Fuels/Fire Potential

Lightning will move to a wider area today. It's expected that a good number of ignitions could lead to high initial attack.

All indices are highlighting South Central, Copper River Basin, Upper Yukon, and west of the Alaska Range with Extreme values. This will support significant growth where active fires exist. FWI shows that lightning ignition and resistance to control is widespread. Spruce Adjectives reinforce this, and indicate potential for a major event.

Smoke is impacting solar heating across the southern 2/3 of the state. This has been slowing fire activity with reports of creeping and single tree torching vs those without smoke describing running and torching. Expect this to continue, though the relief is only temporary and any sunshine will quickly step up fire behavior.

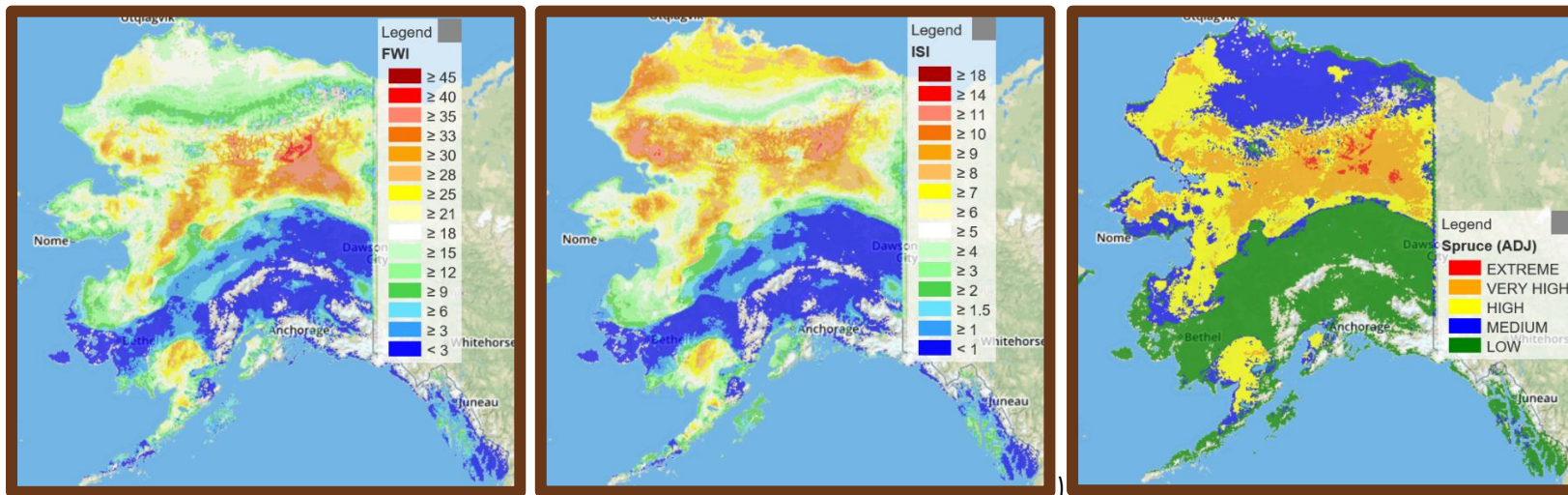
