Coffee Brief

Date: July 19, 2019

Weather Summary

Today will be hot (80s) in the northeast Interior, South Central, and Copper River Basin. Friday will begin to usher in cooler temperatures and higher humidities as the ridge that has been keeping warm and mostly dry weather over Alaska will break in two as a trough drops down from the low in the Arctic. Scattered showers and widely scattered wet thunderstorms will dwindle over Alaska's Interior the next few days, with the last holdout in the southeast mainland.

The Upper Yukon Valley will approach Red Flag criteria on Thursday and Friday as southwest winds increase...but RH values will be too high to reach Red Flag.

The cooler weather will remain through the weekend, with temperatures in South Central starting to rise again on Sunday, and in the Interior on Monday as the ridge builds back in to the north. Beyond that point, model confidence is poor, and there is great disparity in whether the weather remains warm and dry, or more precipitation comes into play.

Fuels/Fire Potential

Spruce Adjectives show ignition and spread potential moderated in many areas, but the northern Interior, Copper River and Susitna Valleys, and northern Kenai Peninsula stay high to very high due to continued fuel dryness.

FWIs in the Yukon Flats will remain Extreme and will intensify over the next few days, with the rest of the northern Interior remaining high to very high.

BUIs are not expected to drop as precipitation really isn't enough to affect deeper layers. Expect fires that do get good precipitation to remain active in deeper duff layers, to resurge at a later date.

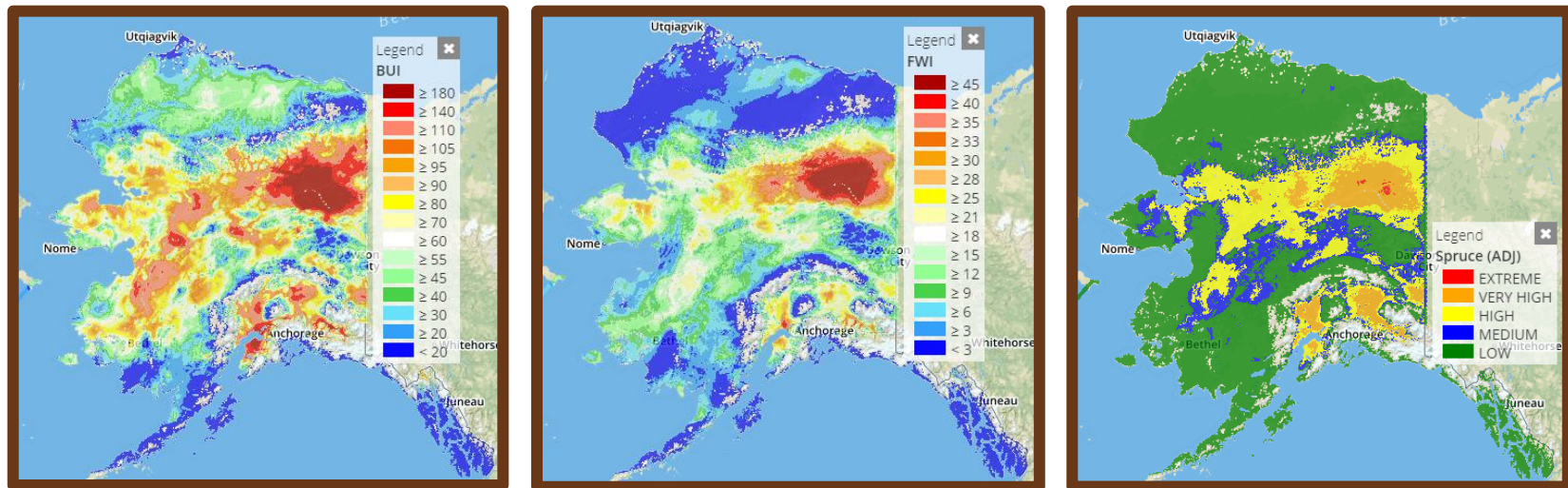
