# Coffee Brief

**Date: July 2, 2019**

## Weather Summary

A low pressure system in the Bering Sea will bring rain to the west coast Tuesday and Wednesday. This second frontal system will not penetrate into mainland Alaska, however, and precipitation will be confined west of a line from Bethel to Bettles. Rather, this feature will only land a glancing blow against coastal Alaska as it moves north into the Chukchi Sea.

Ridging will redevelop over mainland Alaska this week. The ridging will bring a return of hotter and drier conditions to most of Alaska beginning Tuesday and then lasting through the remainder of the week.

## Fuels/Fire Potential

The Upper Yukon Valley and Copper River Basin have very high to extreme values of fire weather indices. Expect fires in these areas to be active, particularly with smoke clearing in the wake of yesterday's frontal passage.

Initial Spread Index (ISI) values remain very high to extreme in the Upper Yukon and Copper River Basin, while other locations that received rainfall have seem moderating ISIs.

The Build-up Index (BUI) and Spruce Adjectives show moderation in Alaska's Interior after yesterday's precipitation. Not all areas received precipitation...some of the moderation in the BUI and Spruce Adjective is due to rising RH.

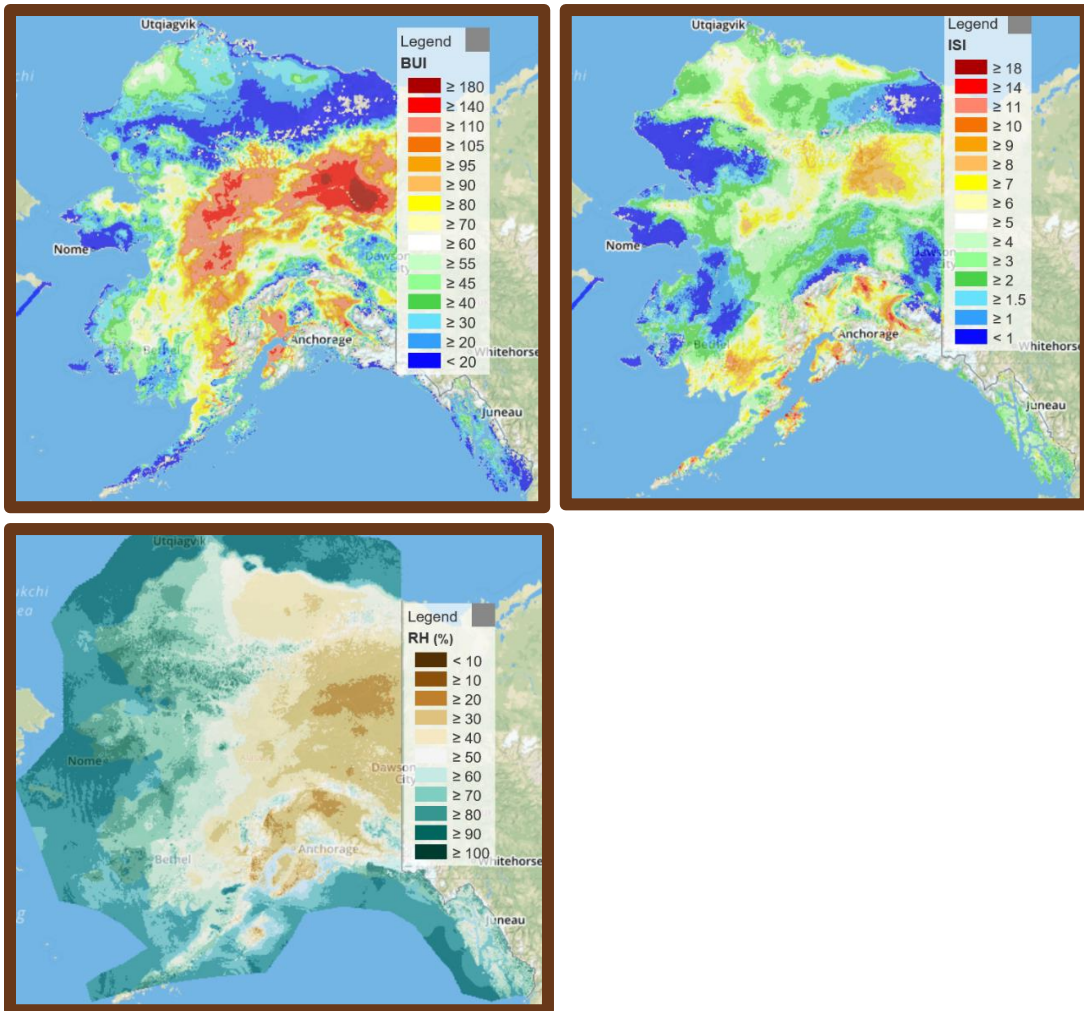
