WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.
 A LARGE UPPER LEVEL TROUGH EXTENDS FROM BARROW SOUTH TO GALENA AND INTO THE GULF OF ALASKA. EAST OF THIS TROUGH, A VERY MOIST ATMOSPHERE IS BEING LIFTED...CAUSING EXTENSIVE CLOUD COVER AND RAIN OVER THE EASTERN TWO-THIRDS OF ALASKA. SOME OF THE RAIN HAS BEEN HEAVY OVER THE CENTRAL TANANA VALLEY, WITH SOME AREAS REPORTING MORE THAN ONE INCH SINCE YESTERDAY. TO THE WEST OF THE TROUGH, CLEARING AND DRYING HAS OCCURRED OVER THE WESTERN GALENA ZONE. THIS TROUGH WILL BE MOVE SLOWLY EAST INTO THE TANANA ZONE TUESDAY...MAINTAINING WET, COOL CONDITIONS ACROSS THE EASTERN INTERIOR UNTIL MIDWEEK. THE ATMOSPHERE IS TOO STABLE STATEWIDE FOR CONVECTION.

WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.
 HIGH PRESSURE IS BEGINNING TO BUILD INTO THE WESTERN AREAS OF ALASKA AS THE LOW PRESSURE WHICH BROUGHT THE RAIN OVER THE LAST FEW DAYS MOVES INTO THE SOUTHEASTERN PANHANDLE. SKIES WILL GRADUALLY CLEAR FROM THE WEST TO EAST AND BY TOMORROW EVENING MOST AREAS SHOULD BE SCATTERED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE EASTERN AREAS. BY MID-WEEK, HIGH PRESSURE WILL DOMINATE ALASKA BRINGING FAIR SKIES AND LITTLE PRECIPITATION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A CHANCE FOR AFTERNOON SHOWERS.
