IT HAS A 50% ACTIVE PERIMETER, AND IS BACKING INTO WIND ON THE NORTH, AND IS ACTIVE IN TWO LONG FINGERS ON THE SOUTH. THE FIRE HAS CROSSED 100-MILE CREEK IN TWO PLACES ON THE SOUTH, AND COULD BURN OUT OF THE HOT ZONE.

SLOPOVERS OCCURRED BUT RETARDANT SUPPORT AND HARD WORK CONTAINED THEM. FLAME LENGTHS UP TO 100 FEET ON THE HEAD, WHICH IS 1/2 MILE WIDE, AND ACTIVE BURNING IN ALL FUEL TYPES WERE OBSERVED. 30% CONTAINED, NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT. CREWS: MIDNIGHT SUNS, FYU#1, DELTA, FAI#1, VEE, CAMP CREW (6). DUBE+155.
