

A transfer of command took place later in the evening, and the jumpers were demobilized off the fire. Seventeen of twenty Helena Type 21A crew members were mobilized to the fire at 2338. The fire is currently smoldering but only holding heat in the root system of the trees, due to it spreading rapidly. Plans for tomorrow consist of securing the edge and working the interior heats. Three more crew members from Helena will be mobilized to the fire from Sleetmute in the morning.
