ON THE COAST WITH 80'S AND 90'S IN INTERIOR LOWER  
ELEVATIONS.

**SOUTHWEST** - PARTLY CLOUDY WITH WIDELY SCATTERED  
AFTERNOON THUNDERSTORMS OVER THE MOUNTAINS.  
THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE MOST NUMEROUS IN EASTERN NEW  
MEXICO. HIGHS WILL BE IN THE 70'S AND 80'S WITH A FEW  
90'S IN ARIZONA.

**FIRE ACTIVITY:** 80 FIRES FOR 1,612 ACRES WERE REPORTED IN  
THE LAST 24 HOURS.

**ANALYSIS:** MINIMAL ACTIVITY OCCURRING NATIONALLY.

**PROGNOSIS:** POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR INCREASING INITIAL  
ATTACK ACTIVITY WITH CONTINUED WARM AND DRY  
WEATHER CONDITIONS THROUGHOUT MOST OF THE  
WEST. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES EXPECTED.

WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION. ....  
WELCOME BACK!!!

WARM AND DRY WEATHER WILL CONTINUE TODAY AND INTO MID WEEK AS AN  
UPPER LEVEL HIGH PRESSURE AREA OVER THE INTERIOR WEAKENS SLOWLY.  
UPPER LEVEL WINDS OVER THE SOUTHEASTERN INTERIOR WILL BE  
INCREASING FROM THE SOUTHEAST AND GRADUALLY BRING A BIT MORE  
MOISTURE INTO THE SOUTHEAST INTERIOR. SUNDAY AFTERNOON A SMALL  
AREA OF CONVECTIVE SHOWERS DEVELOPED IN THE YUKON TERRITORIES IN  
CANADA. A FEW CONVECTIVE CLOUDS COULD DEVELOP THIS AFTERNOON IN  
THE NORTHERN REGION EAST OF TOK WITH AN ISOLATED SHOWER EAST OF  
NORTHWAY. THE REMAINDER OF THE INTERIOR WILL REMAIN UNDER SUNNY  
SKIES AND DRY...THOUGH COOLER THAN ON SUNDAY.

A LOW PRESSURE TROUGH FROM UNALAKLEET TO FAIRBANKS AND EASTWARD  
AND HIGH PRESSURE OVER THE ARCTIC OCEAN ARE CAUSING BRISK  
NORTHEAST WINDS THROUGH THE NORTHERN PORTIONS OF THE ZONES.

UPPER YUKON ZONE AND NORTHERN REGION .....  
CLDS/WX.. SUNNY AND BREEZY. A FEW AFTERNOON CLOUDS EAST OF TOK
