INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
Sunday 6/13/93 0900 MDT
Preparedness Level II

ALASKA: Initial attack and large fire activity.

332248, Tanana Zone, Alaska State - 7,148 acres. Moderate precipitation in the area. No increase in acreage. No estimate of containment.

332266, Tanana Zone, Alaska State - 900 acres. Contained.

NORTHWEST: No significant activity.

CALIFORNIA NORTH ZONE: No activity.

CALIFORNIA SOUTH ZONE: Initial attack activity.

NORTHERN ROCKIES: No significant activity.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN: No significant activity.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN: No significant activity.

SOUTHWEST: Initial attack and large fire activity.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN: Initial attack activity.

EASTERN: No significant activity.

SOUTHERN: Initial attack and large fire activity.

GNAT CATCHER, Okefenokee NWR - 5,700 acres. Type I Team (Mann) committed. The fire is managed under a unified command, with representation from Georgia State, Florida State, and the FWS. Control problems are inaccessibility and hazardous fuels. Private property, timber and wildlife habitat continue to be threatened. Indirect suppression action continues. No estimate of containment.

CANADA: Initial attack and large fire activity.

DEER, Saskatchewan - 212,500 acres. Showers in the area. No threat to life or property. No estimate of containment.

ANALYSIS: Minimal initial attack activity occurred in Alaska, with demobilization in progress on all staffed fires. Initial attack activity has decreased in the Southwest and the Southern Areas.

PROGNOSIS: High temperatures and scattered afternoon thunderstorms are forecast for Florida and southern Georgia. This area should see an increase in initial attack activity due to lightning. Minimal initial attack activity expected in Alaska with rain likely in the northwest, and scattered showers across the central and southern portions of the state. Expect initial attack activity to increase as high pressure builds across the Southwest Area.

A THERMAL LOW PRESSURE TROUGH IS ACROSS THE EAST CENTRAL ALASKAN-CANADIAN YUKON BORDER WITH A NORTHWEST TO SOUTHEAST ORIENTATION. WIDELY SCATTERED CONVECTIVE THUNDERSTORMS ARE EXPECTED AGAIN THIS AFTERNOON AND EVENING OVER THE BRISTOL BAY AREA AND NORTHWARD OVER THE KUSKOKWIM VALLEY THEN EASTWARD ACROSS NORTHERN SECTIONS OF THE MATANUSKA...SUSITNA AND COPPER RIVER VALLEYS. WEAK HIGH PRESSURE DOMINATES MUCH OF THE STATE TODAY. THERE IS STILL THE REMANENTS OF A WEAK TROUGH IN THE NORTHWESTERN PORTION OF THE STATE KEEPING COOL, MOIST CONDITIONS FOR THE NORTHERN PARTS OF KOBUK AND KOTZEBUE SOUND AREAS. THIS TROUGH WILL GRADUALLY EXIT TO THE NORTH THIS AFTERNOON. IN THE SOUTHWESTERN PORTION OF THE STATE, THE UPPER LEVEL LOW CREATING ONSHORE FLOW, WILL MOVE SLIGHTLY SOUTHWARD. THIS SHOULD ALLOW AN INCREASE IN AFTERNOON SUNSHINE FOR MUCH OF THE GALENA ZONE WITH A THREAT OF AFTERNOON CONVECTION, MAINLY FOR HUSLIA AND INNOKO.

DRIER AND WARMER CONDITIONS ARE DEVELOPING IN THE TANANA ZONE, UPPER YUKON ZONE, AND THE NORTHERN REGION FOR TODAY DUE TO THE WEAK HIGH PRESSURE. THERE IS A WEAK THERMAL LOW IN THE TETLIN AREA, BUT THE AIRMASS IS DRIER TODAY THAN YESTERDAY WITH SIMILAR ATMOSPHERIC STABILITY. A FEW EVENING SHOWERS ARE POSSIBLE EAST OF DELTA, BUT WILL BE ISOLATED AND SPOTTY.
