ALASKA, A STRONG MIDDLE LEVEL WARM TROUGH DEVELOPED FROM

ANALYSIS: The Southwest Area reported increased fire activity with several fires escaping initial attack. Fourteen Type I crews within the Southwest area were committed. Resource mobilization occurred throughout the day involving some movement from other geographic areas. Initial attack activity remained moderate in the Southern Area and Alaska.

PRDGNOSIS: A RED FLAG WATCH has been issued in Arizona for strong winds associated with a cold front which is expected to move across the state. Dry lightning is expected in the east. A RED FLAG WATCH is in effect for New Mexico for strong southwest winds. Anticipate initial attack and large fire activity to continue in the Southwest Area. Southern California, Florida and southern Georgia may see an increase in initial attack as these areas continue to have hot, dry weather. Alaska will continue to have minimal activity.


