ALASKA: Initial attack and large fire activity.

332248, Tanana Zone, Alaska State - 17,000 acres. No estimate of containment.

NORTHWEST: No significant activity.

CALIFORNIA NORTH ZONE: No significant activity.

CALIFORNIA SOUTH ZONE: Initial attack activity and large fire activity.

GRADE, San Diego RU, California State - 1,200 acres. Hot desert winds, steep, rocky terrain and inaccessibility are hampering control efforts. Containment expected 6/19.

NORTHERN ROCKIES: Initial attack activity.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN: No significant activity.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN: No significant activity.

SOUTHWEST: Initial attack and large fire activity.

POINT, Kaibab NF - 1,300 acres. Type II Team (Kahon) committed. Containment expected 6/18.

IRON, Coconino NF - 200+ acres. Type II Team committed. Fire is burning in Ponderosa pine due north of the 1990 Dude fire. No estimate of containment.

GRAHAM COMPLEX, Coronado NF - 4,000 acres. Type I team (Shaw) committed. Complex consists of the NOON, TWILIGHT, HELIOGRAPH, GRANT HALL, and GRAPEVIEW fires. No estimate of containment.

PIETY COMPLEX, Arizona State - 4,700 acres. Type II Team (Moore) committed. Complex consists of the PIETY and MARCUM fires. No estimate of containment.

ADOBE, New Mexico State - 150 acres. Containment was expected yesterday, 6/17.

UNION PASS, Phoenix District, BLM - 350 acres. Contained.

UVAS, Las Cruces District, BLM - 1,000 acres. Containment expected 6/23.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN: Initial attack activity.

EASTERN: No activity.

SOUTHERN: Initial attack and large fire activity.

GNAT CATCHER, Okefenokee NWR - 5,711 acres. Type I Team (Mann) demobilized, turning the fire back to the refuge. Containment expected 6/26.

CANADA: Initial attack and large fire activity.

DEER, Saskatchewan - 296,520 acres. No estimate of containment.

ANALYSIS: Initial attack and large fire activity continued in the Southwest Area resulting in the mobilization of additional resources. Good progress was made on several large fires, while others made significant acreage gains. A total of 18 Type 1 crews and 119 individual overhead have been mobilized to the Southwest. Southern California, Florida and southern Georgia experienced minor initial attack activity.

PROGNOSIS: A RED FLAG WATCH is in effect in east central Arizona for low humidities and winds up to 25 mph. The forecast for New Mexico is for scattered thundershowers and gusty winds in the east with dry lightning possible in the central mountains. Initial attack and large fire activity is expected to continue in the Southwest Area. The potential exists for an increase in initial attack in southern California, Florida and southern Georgia with prevailing hot, dry weather.

WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.
 A HIGH PRESSURE HAS BEEN BUILDING AND EXTENDING FROM NORTHWEST OF ALASKA THROUGHOUT THE ATMOSPHERE TO BRING CLEAR SKIES TO NORTHERN PARTS OF THE STATE TODAY AND TOMORROW. MEANWHILE, THE SOUTHERN PARTS PARTICULARLY THE PANHANDLE AND GULF COAST WILL STILL FEEL THE INFLUENCES BY THE GULF LOW SYSTEM, MEANING SOUTHERLY WINDS AND SOME MOISTURE COMING IN. CENTRAL PARTS OF THE STATE TODAY WILL CONTINUE TO HAVE AFTERNOON THUNDERSHOWERS ADDRESSED IN THE ZONE FORECAST.

...WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION...

A STRONG RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE EXTENDS NORTHWARD THRU THE CENTRAL BERING SEA. THIS RIDGE IS EXPECTED TO DRIFT SLOWLY EASTWARD RESULTING IN GENERALLY CLEARING CONDITIONS AND GUSTY NORTHWESTERLY WINDS OVER THE WESTERN MCGRATH ZONE. A LOW CENTERED APPROXIMATELY 250 MILES SOUTHEAST OF KODIAK ISLAND WILL CONTINUE TO DRIFT SLOWLY SOUTHEASTWARD THRU THE FORECAST PERIOD. THE THERMAL TROUGH PERSISTS EAST/WEST GENERALLY ALONG 66 DEGS NORTH LAT. THRU THE CENTRAL INTERIOR. IN THE SOUTHERN ZONES, THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY SHOULD BE RESTRICTED TO THE EXTREME NORTHERN PORTION OF THE MATSU AND COPPER RIVER ZONES.
