Preparedness Level II

ALASKA: Initial attack activity.

NORTHWEST: No significant activity.

CALIFORNIA NORTH ZONE: Initial attack activity.

CALIFORNIA SOUTH ZONE: Initial attack activity.

NORTHERN ROCKIES: No significant activity.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN: No significant activity.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN: Initial attack activity.

SOUTHWEST: Initial attack and large fire activity.

QUEMADO, Santa Fe NF - 3,610 acres. Type II Team (Lente) committed. Current threats are to high value residences and private property. Steep terrain, continuous fuels and high winds continue to cause control problems. Containment expected 7/8.

BRIMLEY, Arizona State - 450 acres. Contained.

CORRAL/FENCE, Arizona State - 1,400 acres. Contained.

MELON, Coconino NF - 400 acres. Contained.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN: Initial attack activity.

EASTERN: No significant activity.

SOUTHERN: No significant activity.

ANALYSIS: Suppression activity was less than anticipated over the holiday weekend, with most geographic areas reporting moderate initial attack. Limited new starts combined with progress on large fires has resulted in some demobilization of resources in the Southwest Area.

PROGNOSIS: The southwestern U.S. will be sunny and hot with low afternoon humidities and locally breezy conditions. Temperatures will range from 70 to the mid 80's in the mountains, with 95 to 105 in the southwest deserts. Initial attack is expected to continue at a moderate level with the lack of thunderstorms in the forecast being a factor. The Southwest Area anticipates continuing progress on large fires and demobilization of additional resources.

WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.

A BOON DAY FOR THE COMPUTER MODELS WITH TOK REPORTING 0.60" OF RAIN IN THE LAST 18 HOURS.

LOOKING AT THE COMPLEX WEATHER PATTERN PRODUCED THAT HEAVY RAINFALL IN THE TETLIN AREA OVERNIGHT SHOWS THE WEAK TROUGH ASSOCIATED WITH THE UPPER LEVEL LOW EXTENDING FROM NORTON SOUND THROUGH THE SOUTHERN BORDER OF THE GALENA ZONE DOWN TO THE NORTH GULF COAST. EMBEDDED ALONG THE EASTERN PORTION OF THIS TROUGH IN THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE STATE IS ANOTHER TROUGH. BASICALLY, A WEAK RIDGE OVER THE CENTER PORTION OF THE STATE IS SURROUNDED BY THE UPPER LEVEL LOW IN THE SOUTHWEST AND THE TROUGH IN THE SOUTHEAST.

THE LOW AND ASSOCIATED TROUGH IN THE WEST WILL MOVE NORTHWARD EXTENDING FROM THE SEWARD PENNINSULA THROUGH, THROUGH THE INNOKO AREA, AND INTO THE NORTHERN GULF COAST BY THIS AFTERNOON. AS A RESULT, CLOUDS AND THE THREAT OF LIGHT SHOWERS WILL SPREAD FARTHER NORTHWARD IN THE GALENA AND TANANA ZONES, BUT RAIN AMOUNTS WILL BE LIGHT. THIS TROUGH SHOULD REMAIN SOUTH OF THE NORTHERN REGION, EXCEPT FOR AREAS NEAR THE ALASKA RANGE, SO ANY PRECIPITATION WOULD BE LIGHT AND SPOTTY. THE EXCEPTION IS IN THE TETLIN AREA AS ANOTHER TROUGH MOVES INTO THE AREA THIS AFTERNOON. RAIN AMOUNTS ARE NOT EXPECTED TO BE AS HEAVY AS LAST NIGHT, HOWEVER.

IN THE UPPER YUKON ZONE, CONDITIONS WILL BE SIMILAR TO YESTERDAY. THE WESTERN TIP OF A THERMAL TROUGH RESIDING IN NORTHWESTERN CANADA WILL HELP CONTINUE ISOLATED AFTERNOON CONVECTION. THE WHITE MOUNTAINS, FORTYMILE, AND AREAS NEAR HIER TERRAIN - LIKE CENTRAL - WILL HAVE A GREATER THREAT OF PRECIPITATION, BUT AMOUNTS SHOULD BE LIGHT AND SPOTTY.
