WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.
 THE DISTURBANCE THAT BROUGHT SIGNIFICANT RAIN TO PARTS OF THE
 INTERIOR YESTERDAY WILL EXIT THE UPPER YUKON TODAY. IN ITS WAKE
 THE AIR REMAINS UNSTABLE, SO CONSIDERABLE WET THUNDERSTORM
 ACTIVITY WILL OCCUR AGAIN TODAY FROM THE UPPER YUKON ZONE
 SOUTHWEST INTO THE SOUTHERN GALENA ZONE. UPPER LEVEL HIGH
 PRESSURE BUILDING INTO THE REGION ON FRIDAY AND OVER THE WEEKEND
 BRING WARM AND DRIER CONDITIONS, BUT GREATLY DIMINISHED
 THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY OVER THE INTERIOR. BEST CHANCE OF
 THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY WILL SHIFT FROM ALASKA RANGE SOUTH OVER THE
 WEEKEND.

...WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION...

A WEAK RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE FROM SOUTHEAST ALASKA INTO THE SUSITNA VALLEY WILL PERSIST AND THEREFORE KEEP THE RELATIVE HUMIDITIES LOW IN THE LOWER YUKON TERRITORY AND IN THE EASTERN COPPER RIVER BASIN AND THE EASTERN TANANA VALLEY. THE SURFACE THERMAL TROP ALONG THE SOUTHERN SLOPES OF THE BROOKS RANGE WILL PERSIST, KEEPING THE MOST UNSTABLE AIR ACROSS THE INTERIOR. THE LARGE LOW SOUTH OF COLD BAY WILL SLOWLY DRIFT EAST CAUSING A WEAK ONSHORE FLOW INTO SOUTHERN COASTAL ALASKA. THIS WILL KEEP CONDITIONS CLOUDY AND MOIST FROM PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND WEST.
