WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION.
 THE UPPER LEVEL HIGH PRESSURE RIDGE REMAINS ENTRENCHED ACROSS THE INTERIOR WITH A CENTER NEAR MACKENZIE BAY. VERY WARM TEMPERATURES WILL CONTINUE ACROSS THE INTERIOR WITH MODERATELY UNSTABLE CONDITIONS OVER THE CENTRAL INTERIOR. MORE STABLE CONDITIONS PERSIST IN THE EASTERN UPPER YUKON ZONE AND IN THE FAR WESTERN GALENA ZONE. INDICATIONS ARE THAT THIS RIDGE WILL BREAK DOWN DURING MIDWEEK, BRING COOLER MORE STABLE AIR TO THE WESTERN INTERIOR WEDNESDAY, AND TO THE ENTIRE INTERIOR BY THURSDAY.

WEATHER SYNOPSIS AND MAP DISCUSSION...

FRONTAL LOW CENTER NEAR FAIRBANKS PERSISTS AND EXTENDS A TROUGH TO
 SOUTHWEST TO THE BRISTOL BAY COAST NEAR DILLINGHAM. CONDITIONS
 REMAIN UNSTABLE ALONG THE KUSKOKWIM VALLEY, ALONG THE NORTH BRISTOL
 COAST AND UPPER MAT-SU VALLEY WITH DEVELOPMENT OF CONVECTIVE
