A TEMPORARY FLIGHT RESTRICTION IS IN PLACE OVER THE FIRE, REDUCED TO 5,000 FT, 5 MILE RADIUS. FIRE A416 IS WITHIN THE PERIMETER OF A321. THE FIRE HAS RECEIVED 1.5" OF RAIN IN THE LAST THREE DAYS. CONTINUED HIGH HUMIDITIES AND LOW TEMPERATURES AND AFTERNOON THUNDERSHOWERS HAVE ELIMINATED THE RISK OF FIRE SPREAD FOR THE NEXT FEW DAYS. THE AIR NATIONAL GUARD MADE AN FLIR FLIGHT AROUND THE FIRE AND FOUND SEVERAL HOT AREAS ON THE EASTERN PERIMETER. MAJOR EMPHASIS IS BEING PLACED ON REHABILITATION OF THE LINE ALONG WITH MOP UP. 15% CONTAINED. NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT (FIRE FIGHTERS ARE RESTRICTED FROM MOST OF THE FIRE BECAUSE IT IS IN A MILITARY BOMBING AREA CONTAINING UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE). TENTATIVE DEMOBILIZATION OF ALL EARLY NEXT WEEK. COMMITED: 2 TYPE II HELICOPTERS, 1 TYPE III HELICOPTER, 2 MILITARY DOZERS. ONE NODWELL. CREWS: NORTHSTAR, FAI#4, FAI#5, FAI#6, DELTA CAMP, KALTAG#2, MARSHALL, AND FAIRBANKS CAMP, 20 SMJ. IC J. STIRES + 184

SMOLDERING DOZER PILES WERE OBSERVED ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE BURN. SUPPRESSION OF THESE ARE OF A LOW PRIORITY BUT ACTION WILL BE TAKEN BY THE END OF THE ASSIGNMENT. THE CREWS CONTINUED TO GRID AROUND THE ENTIRE BURN 1000 FEET IN FROM THE PERIMETER, AND ARE STILL FINDING HOT SPOTS. TYPE II TEAM (DUBE) WAS REPLACED BY TYPE III TEAM (BANISTER).
