ENGINEER HILL: THE FIRE WAS REPORTED AT 10 ACRES, RUNNING AND SPOTTING IN BLACK SPRUCE AND TUNDRA. THE FIRE IS LOCATED 19 MILES EAST OF FAIRBANKS AND 8 MILES NORTH OF EIELSON AIR FORCE BASE. TWO LOADS OF SMOKEJUMPERS AND TWO AIRTANKERS RESPONDED. SIX LOADS OF RETARDANT WERE DROPPED. THE FIRE RAPIDLY GREW TO MORE THAN 100 ACRES. THE DENALI HOT SHOTS AND NORTHSTARS CREWS WERE SHUTTLED TO THE FIRE. TWO ADDITIONAL TYPE 2 CREWS WILL BE SENT TO THE FIRE ON SUNDAY 6/6. I.C. +51.
