DONNELLY FLATS: THE FIRE WAS REPORTED BY STATE TROOPERS. THE FIRE IS LOCATED FIVE MILES SOUTH OF FORT GREELY. INITIAL REPORTS INDICATED FIRE SIZE AT 5 ACRES, BURNING IN BLACK SPRUCE, AND MAKING RUNS TO THE SOUTH AND EAST. DELTA FORESTRY ENGINES AND HELITACK, AFS SMOKEJUMPERS, STATE AND AFS AIRTANKERS, AND AIR ATTACK MADE THE INITIAL ATTACK. MULTIPLE AIR TANKER MISSIONS DELIVERED 30,000 GALLONS OF RETARDANT. AT 1930 THE FIRE WAS 100% ACTIVE WITH 50 TO 60 FT. FLAME LENGTHS, ONE MPH RATE OF SPREAD WITH A ONE HALF MILE FRONT AND EXHIBITING HIGH RESISTANCE TO CONTROL. A FIRE WHORL UP TO 100 FT. WIDE WAS OBSERVED AND CAUSED THE FIRE TO TURN, RUNNING TO THE NORTH AND WEST. CURRENT THREATS ARE TO THE ALYESKA PIPE LINE PUMP STATION NINE, THREE MILES TO THE WEST, AND HOMESTEADS ALONG THE RICHARDSON HIGHWAY WEST AND NORTHWEST OF THE FIRE. A TYPE TWO INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM, 15 LINE CREWS, 3 HELICOPTERS AND ADDITIONAL OVERHEAD AND EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING AN AERIAL FIRING GROUP HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO THE FIRE. NO EST. OF CONTAINMENT.
