THE FIRE HAD STARTED IN GRASS AND SPREAD TO TWO LOG HOMES AND ONE FRAME HOUSE BUT DID NOT THREATEN THE WILDLANDS. THE CAUSE OF THE FIRE IS UNDER INVESTIGATION. THE SMOKEJUMPERS PROVIDED PUMP AND HOSE EQUIPMENT FOR THE VILLAGE TO COMPLETE MOP-UP.
