DAILY FIRE SUMMARY

Here is the daily fire summary from the Alaska Interagency Fire Information Center for Tuesday, May 30, 2000.

Five fires were put out by state and local firefighters in Alaska Monday. Three fires were in the Matanuska-Susitna Area, one on the Kenai Peninsula and the other near Tetlin. The largest was three acres. The others were less than half an acre. All were human caused.

Currently seven fires are active in Alaska. None of the fires is staffed. So far this year the Alaska Interagency Coordination Center reports 143 fires statewide have burned 1,225 acres. The AICC coordinates fire management resources for the BLM Alaska Fire Service and the Alaska Division of Forestry.
