BORDER FIRE: 2 FS PERSONNEL WALKED THE PERIMETER AND DRY MOPPED SOME SPOTS OUTSIDE THE LOGGING UNIT. AT THE END OF THE DAY, NO SMOKE WAS SHOWING AND A GENERAL RAIN WAS FALLING. NO FS PERSONNEL WERE ON SITE TODAY. AERIAL SURVEILLANCE CONTINUES, THE PROJECT IS ON A MAIN FLYWAY FOR FS AND COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS. EARLY FOG, FOLLOWED BY SCATTERED CLOUDS AND HIGH HUMIDITIES TODAY. LOGGERS WILL MONITOR THE CONDITIONS AND CONTACT THE DISTRICT IF SMOKE APPEARS. THIS WILL BE THE LAST REPORT UNLESS THERE ARE SMOKE DETECTED, OR UNTIL THE FIRE IS DECLARED OUT.
