THE PERIMETER AS A WHOLE IS 60% ACTIVE WITH TWO-FOOT FLAME LENGTHS AND LIMITED SPOTTING LESS THAN 100'. THE FIRE IS NOW 2.2 MILES NW OF THE HOMESTEAD AND CONTINUING TO BACK TOWARD IT. THE FIRE MOVED .3 MILES CLOSER IN THE PAST 24 HOURS, AND IS SEVEN DAYS AWAY AT THE CURRENT RATE OF SPREAD CALCULATED FROM ARC VIEW. A NATIVE ALLOTMENT LIES 5.8 MILES TO THE NORTH OF THE FIRE AT THIS TIME. THE FIRE MOVED .9 MILES CLOSER IN THE PAST 24 HOURS. THE FIRE WILL REACH THE ALLOTMENT IN ABOUT 6 DAYS AT THE CURRENT RATES OF SPREAD CALCULATED FROM ARCVIEW.

UPPER OTTER CREEK: THE NPS REPORTED THE FIRE HAS EXPERIENCED SIGNIFICANT GROWTH IN THE LAST 24 HOURS. IT WAS ONE ACRE IN SIZE YESTERDAY AND IS NOW 395 ACRES. IT HAS GROWN IN ALL DIRECTIONS EVENLY FROM THE POINT OF ORIGIN. THE FIRE BEHAVIOR IS NEARLY IDENTICAL TO THE OTHER NPS FIRES IN THE AREA, A-288 AND A-303. IT IS ON THE GROUND IN THE TUNDRA WITH 2-4 FOOT FLAME LENGTHS AND A FLAME ZONE DEPTH OF 2-6 FEET. THE PERIMETER IS 50% ACTIVE. HARDWOOD STANDS WERE SUPPORTING FIRE ON THE GROUND AT A SLOWER RATE, BUT WERE NOT A COMPLETE BARRIER TO FIRE SPREAD. SOME HARDWOOD STANDS WERE SCORCHED TO THE CROWNS AND FIRE WAS SEEN BURNING UP THE BOLES OF THE TREES. ISOLATED POCKETS OF SPRUCE WERE SEEN TORCHING, BUT INDEPENDENT CROWN FIRE IS NOT OCCURRING DUE TO THE SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE SPRUCE FUELS. THE FIRE IS EASILY CROSSING SMALL CREEKS IN THE AREA, SPOTTING DISTANCE IS UNDER 100'. THERE ARE NO STRUCTURES IMMEDIATELY THREATENED BY THE FIRE, AND IT LIES ENTIRELY WITHIN A LIMITED SUPPRESSION ZONE.
