N24KM FLEW THE FIRE AT 18:15 WHEN THE FIRE WAS 10 ACRES BURNING IN TUNDRA AND OCCASIONALLY TORCHING IN SPRUCE. LAND MANAGER DECIDED TO TAKE ACTION DUE TO PROXIMITY OF FIRE TO ALLOTMENTS AND LACK OF NATURAL BARRIERS AVAILABLE TO PROTECT THEM. NORTH SHORE KENAI LAKE: THIS PRESCRIBED FIRE ORIGINALLY WAS STARTED ON JULY 16. THE PRESCRIBED FIRE ESCAPED CONTROL LINES ON 6/25. LOCATED AT THE NORTH SIDE OF THE LAKE. WINDS CONTRIBUTED TO SPOTTING AND ESCAPE. THE FIRE IS STILL INSIDE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE PERIMETER. HOWEVER THERE HAS BEEN DRYING FOR SEVERAL DAYS. THE FIRE CROSSED THE LINE AT BOTTOM CORRIDOR AND MADE A RUN UPHILL. MOST OF THE TIMBER IS BLOW DOWN FROM THE SPRUCE BEETLE KILL. THE FIRE HAS SPOTTED A 1/4 MILE AWAY WITH A SPOT FIRE OF 50 ACRES. A TYPE 1 OVERHEAD TEAM HAS BEEN ORDERED AS WELL AS 2 TYPE I CREWS, 4 TYPE II CREWS, 2 MED HELICOPTERS, 1 TYPE I HELICOPTER, AND ONE LIGHT HELI.

GAINS WERE NOTED ON EASTERN AND NORTHERN SIDES IN THE AREA EAST OF THE  
TOTATLANIKA RIVER. FIRE RETARDANT WAS DROPPED ON HOT SPOTS. CREWS ON  
THE NORTHERN PERIMETER WILL CONNECT THE FIRELINE INTO THE TOTATLANIKA  
RIVER TONIGHT. GOOD PROGRESS WAS ALSO MADE ON SOUTHWESTERN PERIMETER  
LINE CONSTRUCTION, AIDED BY HIGHER HUMIDITIES. A STRUCTURE PROTECTION  
GROUP CONTINUED ASSESSING STRUCTURES ALONG THE PARKS HWY AND IN THE  
WINDY CREEK AREA. TOMORROW CREWS WILL SECURE LINE BETWEEN TAIL OF FIRE  
AND TOTATLANIKA RIVER. THE AERIAL FIRING GROUP WILL ASSESS THE  
FEASIBILITY OF IGNITING POCKETS OF FUEL BETWEEN THE TOTATLANIKA CK AND  
THE SOUTHERN EDGE OF THE FIRE. CREWS WILL WORK ON A NEW DIVISION C, AT  
THE SOUTHERN EDGE OF THE FIRE, SECURING A SLOP OVER SOUTH OF THE REX  
TRAIL. DOZERS WILL STAGE AT 7 MILE LAKE. SMOKE JUMPERS WILL ASSESS  
PROTECTION NEEDS AT CABINS AND ALLOTMENTS AND DEPLOY SPRINKLERS AS  
NEEDED. IC + 313. +26,857 ACRES.
