 SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE FIRE. CREWS SECURED SLOPOVERS AND CONSTRUCTED
 FIRELINE. SMOKEJUMPERS ASSESSED THREATS TO CABINS AND ALLOTMENTS AND
 DEPLOYED SPRINKLER SYSTEMS. DOZERS STAGED AT 7 MILE LAKE FOR POTENTIAL
 CABIN PROTECTION. THE STRUCTURE PROTECTION GROUP CONTINUED TO WORK ON
 ASSESSING STRUCTURES ALONG THE PARKS HWY, THE WINDY CK AREA AND 7 MILE
 LAKE. RETARDANT WAS USED TO ASSIST SUPPRESSION. HELICOPTER OPERATIONS
 ARE TEMPORARILY SHUT DOWN FOR INVESTIGATION OF A HELICOPTER INCIDENT.
 WILL HAVE SMOKEJUMPERS CONDUCT BURNOUT OPERATIONS ON 6/27 ALONG THE
 REX TRAIL WORKING FROM THE TOTATLANIKA R WEST TO H-45. BURNOUT WILL BE
 SUPPORTED BY AIR OPERATIONS. IC +319 ACREAGE INCREASE: 11,956.0
