 VOLUNTARY EVACUATION BEGAN 6/27 AT 1700. WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO BE 20

 THE EASTERN KENAI PENINSULA HAS BEEN ISSUED FOR 6/28 FOR STRONG WINDS

FISH CK: HIGHER HUMIDITIES KEPT FIRE BEHAVIOR MINIMAL. THE SLOPOVER SOUTH OF REX TRAIL CONTAINED THE MOST HEAT AND WAS THE MOST ACTIVE. ACREAGE GAIN TODAY REFLECTS THE AERIAL FIRING UPDATE AND EVENING SLOPOVERS SOUTH OF THE REX TRAIL. CREWS ON THE NORTH PERIMETER MOPPED UP 100' SECURING THE FIRELINE TO THE TOTATLANIKA RIVER. CREWS CONTAINED FOUR OF THE SLOPOVERS SOUTH OF THE REX TRAIL. PARACARGO PROVIDED LOGISTICAL SUPPORT TO THE JUMPERS AND CREW AT THE TOTATLANIKA/REX TRAIL SLOPOVER. SMOKE JUMPERS ASSESSED THREATS TO CABINS AND ALLOTMENTS AND DEPLOYED SPRINKLER SYSTEMS. DOZERS STAGED AT 7 MILE LAKE FOR POTENTIAL CABIN PROTECTION. THE STRUCTURE PROTECTION GROUP CONTINUED TO WORK ON ASSESSING STRUCTURES ALONG THE PARKS HWY, THE WINDY CK AREA AND 7 MILE LAKE. A CRITICAL INCIDENT STRESS DEBRIEFING TEAM AND CRASH INVESTIGATION TEAM ARRIVED ON THE INCIDENT TODAY. THE INVESTIGATION OF THE HELICOPTER INCIDENT WILL CONTINUE. TOMORROW (6/28) CREWS IN DIV. A WILL MOP UP 300' IN SECURING LINE BETWEEN TAIL OF FIRE AND TOTATLANIKA RIVER. ASSESSMENT OF ROADSIDE HOME SITES IN THE FIRE AREA WILL CONTINUE HOT SHOT CREWS WILL BE SHUTTLED TO DIV. C TO PREP POCKETS OF UNBURNED FUEL NORTH OF REX TRAIL FOR POSSIBLE BURN. CREWS AND SMOKE JUMPERS WILL SET UP HOSELAYS TO SECURE LARGE SLOPOVER NEAR CABIN 048. DOZERS WILL STAGE AT 7 MILES LAKE. BURNOUT WILL BE SUPPORTED BY AIR OPERATION. IC + 315.
