TEAM ARRIVED ON THE INCIDENT FOR THE HELICOPTER INVESTIGATION.
6-29 CREWS IN DIV A WILL MOP UP 300' IN SECURING LINE BETWEEN TAIL OF
FIRE AND TOTATLANIKA RIVER. ASSESSMENT OF ROADSIDE HOMESITES IN
FIRE AREA WILL CONTINUE. HOT SHOT CREWS WILL PREP POCKETS OF
UNBURNED FUEL NORTH OF REX TRAIL FOR PLANNED BURNOUT, SUPPORTED BY
AIR OPERATIONS. DOZERS WILL CONTINUE TO STAGE AT 7 MILE LAKE. AN IR
FLIGHT HAS BEEN ORDERED AND THE INFRA CAM WILL BE USED IN THE MOPPED
UP AREAS. FIRE ACTIVITY IS EXPECTED TO INCREASE DUE TO LOWER
HUMIDITIES, HIGHER TEMPERATURES AND PASSING THUNDERSTORMS. IC + 318.
