RED FOX : FIRE ORIGINATED ON STATE FOREST LAND 1 1/2 MILES NE OF TOK CITY PROPERTY. INCIDENT WAS INITIAL ATTACKED WITH 4 ENGINES FROM TOK FORESTRY, LOCALS, VFD'S DELTA HELITACK, RETARDANT, AND SMOKEJUMPERS. FIRE BEHAVIOR CONSISTED OF TORCHING, RUNNING AND SPOTTING STRONGLY INFLUENCED BY WINDS (20MPH) AND PASSING THUNDERSTORM. FIRE PROGRESSED IN A SOUTHEASTERLY FASHION INTO RESIDENTIAL AREAS. AN EVACUATION OF NE SIDE OF TOWN WAS IMPLEMENTED AT 1455 HRS. 2 STRUCTURES AND 1 OUTBUILDING WERE LOST AND THE PERIMETER SURROUNDED 6 HOUSES. 4 DOZERS, 5 FAF ENGINES, AND 2 CREWS REINFORCED SUPPRESSION EFFORTS. CAUSE OF FIRE IS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

IN. STRUCTURE PROTECTION GROUP WILL CONTINUE ASSESSING HOMESITES ALONG THE PARKS HIGHWAY FROM NENANA TO FERRY. CREWS WILL HOLD AND MOP UP REX TRAIL AREA AS BURNOUT OPERATIONS ARE COMPLETED. DOZERS WILL CONTINUE TO STAGE AT 7 MILE LAKE. FIRE ACTIVITY WILL INCREASE DUE TO LOWER HUMIDITIES, HIGHER TEMPERATURES AND PASSING THUNDERSTORMS. FIRE IS EXPECTED TO SPREAD TO THE NORTH AND NORTHEAST IN UNSTAFFED AREAS.
