FORESTRY HELICOPTER WITH BUCKET AND ENGINE CREWS FROM FORESTRY AND VFD KNOCKED THE FIRE DOWN. NO STRUCTURES WERE LOST. CAUSE IS BEING INVESTIGATED. PERSONNEL WILL WORK THROUGH NIGHT MOPPING UP AND GRIDDING FIRE. DEMOBE EXPECTED 7/02 AFTERNOON.
