SMOKEJUMPERS, A HAND CREW AND AN ENGINE CREW HAVE BEEN DESIGNATED TO SUPPORT THE TOK UNIT INITIAL ATTACK IF NECESSARY. A COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE IS BEING PLANNED FOR WEDNESDAY TO DISCUSS THE CURRENT SITUATION ON THE FIRE, PREVENTION ISSUE, AND DEFENSIBLE SPACE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PREVENTION TEAM ARRIVING ON THE FIRE TODAY. FIRE PERIMETER WAS MAPPED USING GPS TODAY. ACREAGE INCREASE OF 30.0 ACRES REFLECTS INCLUSION OF SPOTS ON NORTHEAST FLANK OF FIRE. THERE HAS BEEN NO CHANGE IN THE FIRE PERIMETER SINCE 6/30.
