KENAI LAKE: TYPE III TEAM IN PLACE. FIREFIGHTERS HAVE EXTINGUISHED 800 FEET IN FROM THE EDGE OF THE FIRE. UNDER CURRENT AND EXPECTED WEATHER CONDITIONS, THE FIRE SHOULD NOT HAVE ANY CHANCE OF JUMPING THE FIRE LINES. CREW SPENT TIME CLEANING UP THE PTARMIGAN AND TRAIL RIVER CAMPGROUNDS, WHICH HAVE BEEN CLOSED DUE TO THE FIRE. THE WORK WILL CONSIST OF FELLING MANY OF THE DEAD AND DYING SPRUCE TREES. CAMPGROUNDS ARE EXPECTED TO OPEN IN A FEW DAYS.
