Narrative: Fire started 5/27 as 5 acres. Expanded to over 1600 acres. 5 spot fires crossed the river. The largest is 50 acres. Air attack and tanker will work on the largest spot. Crews continue to work the smaller spots using boats for access and helicopters with buckets. A Type II team (Reed) has been ordered and is en route. 4 Type I crews are also on order. Currently, 4 Type II crews and 8 smokejumpers are working the fire. Fire is 20% contained. Limited resources committed to fire and lack of available resources statewide hamper containment efforts for the size and complexity of fire. There is potential to continue growth and spread towards town of Tok. Fire grew from 1400 acres to 2690 acres and is moving out of Tetlin Reservation.
