Narrative: The fire was reported by multiple callers. FD and VFD, Forestry engines, Forestry Helitack and Air Attack initially responded. A van of jumpers were requested and responded by ground. The fire was burning in mixed hardwoods and spruce, creeping with minor runs and minimal spotting. Helicopter bucket work, engines and fedcos were used to knock down the fire. There were large burn piles along the road as well as a shed with some potential haz-mat which caused complications. The shed was destroyed. The fire had a very poorly defined perimeter and is very spotty. It was expected to require extensive gridding. An IHC crew has been requested for 5/29 due to this gridding need. 2 Forestry Techs, 6 IA EFF and 1 Type 2 crew remained on the fire overnight. Twenty three personnel are currently staffing the fire.

Narrative: The fire was discovered by a detection aircraft. Upon arrival, the fire was 0.1 acre along the lake shore with no open flame. Thirty minutes later open flame was visible and activity was picking up due to strong south winds. The fire was spotting 100-150 feet and all spots were igniting. Two helicopters from McGrath, an ASM, 2 tankers, 1 CL-215 and a load of smokejumpers were requested. The 14 person Nikolai crew was hired and delivered to the fire. The CL-215, tankers, and helicopter bucket drops were effective in boxing the fire in. It is planned to have the Yukon Type 2 crew delivered to the fire and pull the smokejumpers off on 5/28. Thirty personnel are currently staffing the fire.
