Narrative: The fire was reported to Forestry dispatch from Anchorage Flight Service. A large smoke was reported in the Flat Horn Lake area. J-66 was diverted from fire 070 to investigate the fire, 8 jumpers attacked the fire. One structure was determined to be lost and the cause of the wildland fire. The fire spotted across Fish Creek. A local resident shuttled 2 smokejumpers across the river to suppress the spot fire, burning in black spruce. Helicopter 389EH and two helitack crewmembers assisted with the suppression of the spotfire. Pump and hoselays were set up. Paracargo was delivered to the fire by J-66. 8 smokejumpers will remain on the fire through the night to finish cutting line.

Narrative: The local 911 dispatch reported a large column of black smoke. VFD and Forestry units responded to the area. Helitack assistance was requested due to difficulty accessing the fire. On arrival, the fire was 1+ acre, burning in the old Miller's Reach burn area. The fire was very active and spreading rapidly. As some critical tactical resources were already in use on fires in the Soldotna area, a tanker and ASM were ordered from Fairbanks. A load of smokejumpers was requested to land in Palmer and shuttle to the fire by ground. Additional bucket assistance from an Anchorage Fire Department helicopter was also requested, once command was established. A TFR was initiated to mitigate hazards because of all the aircraft flying in the area. ASM B-7 further controlled the air traffic upon arrival. T-51 dropped a load of retardant on numerous passes over the fire, then landed in Palmer for hold. Mechanical difficulties then put the tanker out of service at Palmer. Additional personnel responded to this fire, including the Gannet Glacier T-2 Crew and more engines. The jumpers initially ordered for this fire were diverted to jump one with no road access, another load was ordered to replace them for this fire. The forestry helicopter was also diverted to fire 072 to suppress a spot fire across the river. During the initial attack phase of this fire, it was reported that one structure, 15 vehicles, one bulldozer, and multiple out buildings were burned. This fire grew from 1 acre to 19.1 acres during its initial attack phase. It was not contained or controlled, and will be staffed through the evening.
