Narrative: Red Flag conditions hindered firefighting efforts throughout the day. The fire was active at 8:30 am. It spotted across the Parks Highway and structures were threatened. The spot across the Parks grew to 100 acres. Structure protection for cabins along the Tanana River was supported by boats. The fire jumped the railroad tracks in the afternoon. Winds switched throughout the day and evening limiting visibility and air operations. The Highway was closed intermittently due to extreme fire behavior and poor visibility. The Alaska Railroad passenger trains were guided through the fire area as conditions allowed. Fire activity increased in the evening. Residents were evacuated and the Parks Highway was shut down. The power grid for the whole area was down during the late evacuation and road closure. Four airtankers and air attack worked through the evening. Crews and engines worked on structure protection throughout the day and will continue during night shift. Two structures were lost.
