Narrative: The fire continued to spread to the east and crossed portions of the Totatlanika River. A spot fire was found on an island in the Tanana River, which is being patrolled by boat. Two fuel tank farms are threatened west of the highway, and a subdivision southeast of the City of Nenana is threatened. The power grid for the City of Nenana was down for a portion of last evening causing problems with the radio communication. A voluntary evacuation was implemented in Nenana with evacuation centers in Nenana and Fairbanks. The highway and railroad corridors continue to be impacted. A red flag warning was in effect, and heavy winds caused running, crowning, torching and spotting.
