Narrative: 140 people attended a public meeting in Nenana on June 10th to discuss the fire situation and the voluntary evacuation plan. Crews continue to do structure protection, securing line, and mopping up around structures, doing burn outs as necessary. With southerly winds continuing to push the fire north towards the Tanana River, boats and engines continue to patrol areas around the river corridor. The Parks Highway remains open with some delays. New divisions were formed to work south of the fire along the Parks Highway to prepare for possible shifting winds creating new fire growth.
