Narrative: Good progress toward the containment of this fire is being made, yet residences and other structures remain at risk. Traffic on the Parks Highway is now fully open, with only minor delays. The voluntary evacuation for the Nenana area was lifted, and some residents returned home. Crews continued securing line and mop up around structures. The dozer line was prepared for burnout operations, given the conditions remain favorable. Winds are expected to shift from southerly to west-northwest, toward the Tatlanika river, through large stands of black spruce. Structure protection needs are being assessed from Mile 284 to 287 of the Parks Highway.

Narrative: The fire was flown by State Detection and mapped by 284CA. It was 85% active. The wind was 285 degrees at 8-10 miles per hour. Active backing into the wind on the north side of the fire was observed and, burning in tundra, blackspruce, and hardwoods. Pockets of white spruce are being taken out along the east flanks where it is paralleling the Little Delta River. Stringers of Aspen hardwoods have slowed the momentum of the fire along the river. To the south the fire was advancing to the ridge of an un-named drainage. The west flank was active primarily in tundra and blackspruce. No natural barriers were observed to the north of the fire. The winter trail originating at the Little Delta River would provide the only break in the fuels. The width varied from 5 to 15 feet. The trail appeared wet in most areas but would provide access.
