Narrative: Range control personnel reported a 25 meter by 25 meter fire burning in the Stuart Creek Impact Area. The fire was flown by zone surveillance aircraft N756ZV. It was discovered that the fire consisted of five small spot fires, was 25% active and running in grass. The fire was located in a limited management area and was placed in monitor status. By 6:45 PM the five individual fires had grown into one large fire approximately 175 acres in size. The fire perimeter was 15% active, creeping and running in grass with one to two foot flame lengths. The fire remains in monitor status.

Upon arrival the fire was 2.5 acres, 50% active, with 1-2 ft. flame lengths. Structures in the area were not threatened. 633 started bucket work, and the fire was knocked down at 1827. The fire was called contained at 1904. Prevention is investigating. The fire was put in monitor status.

Upon arrival F76 found one truck engulfed in flames, minimal spread to wildlands, and no additional resources needed. F76 cancelled helitack and F72. The fire was knocked down at 12:58, and contained and controlled at 14:26. The fire was put in monitor status.

Narrative: The fire was reported to Homer police at 2230 on 5/19/08. DOF resources responded 5/20/08 at 0730. Upon arrival the crews had to hike in as access was difficult. Air attack responded and reported the fire was 25 acres. By late morning the fire had doubled in size. Airtankers worked the fire throughout the day. One load of smokejumpers, three T2 crews and one T1 crew were in place by evening. The latest reported size of the fire is 300 acres, burning in grass, understory and Beetle Kill standing spruce.
