The fire was burning extremely rapidly through black spruce and hardwoods. The wind was out of the south at three to seven miles per hour and skies were 40 percent cloudy. Eight smokejumpers were deployed and began structure assessments and protection utilizing sprinklers and hoselays. Narrative: At 1237 the fire was flown by zone surveillance aircraft N9011N. The fire was approximately 1250 acres in size, 40% active and backing in tundra with isolated torching in black spruce. The southern flank was most active. One load of smokejumpers were ordered for structure protection on the fryingpan creek drainage.

At 1328 smokejumper aircraft Jump-07 delivered 8 smokejumpers to the fire who began structure protection preparations. By 1450 Jump-07 personnel reported the fire to be approximately 1500 acres in size.

At 1734 Fire Specialist Higgins established a checkpoint at mile post 94 on the Stesse Highway and began to asses sites off the highway for structure protection options.

At 1855 smokejumper aircraft Jump-17 delivered a load of para-cargo to the smokejumpers at the site on Fryingpan Creek. The smokejumpers continued to prepare for burnout operations around the site.
