DOF was also assisted by personnel from the Alaska Fire Service. Fire suppression will continue to the end of this operational period and will continue tomorrow.
4/29 Fire resources continued to mop-up; returning to forestry at the end of shift. IC has placed the fire in monitor status and will return tomorrow with fire personnel, continuing to mop-up.
