This fire reported from 4/2. PER Kodiak Dispatch: 911 dispatch for a small fire next to the "bike path" adjacent to the 2600 block Rezanof Drive East. F-1 and E-1 responded. Kodiak Police Department units were also on scene and report that they have extinguished the fire with their fire extinguisher from their cruiser. E-1 crew surveyed the small grass fire and approximate the dimensions at 4' x 4' of dried grass that burned. A KPD officer reports that the fire was flaming and not just smoldering. KFD with a shovel, thermal imaging camera and water can extinguished the remaining embers. All KFD units cleared and returned to service.
