Subject: Incident Management Response Roundtable Calls

Background: The National Multi-Agency Coordinating Group (NMAC) was asked to support the Incident Management Response Roundtable (IMRR). NMAC views IMRR as a valuable interagency forum benefiting the Incident Management Team (IMT) community and those they serve.

Purpose and Tenets of IMRR Calls:

- **Functional Area Proficiency**
 - Provide an interagency forum to:
 - Share insights and educational resources to enhance knowledge of incident management and improve individual performance.
 - Stay updated on new practices.
 - Maintain position-specific skills.
- **IMT Information Sharing**
 - Disseminate official updates from governing bodies, advisory councils, and working teams.
 - Invite representatives of those groups to provide updates and speak directly.

For IMRR to remain successful, calls must follow established ground rules and be self-regulated by the IMRR facilitators. NMAC will work with the facilitators to establish expectations for facilitation of the functional area calls.

NMAC would also like to remind IMRR of NMAC Letter L2022-02 which identifies NMAC as the entry point for IMRR recommendations/requests into the wildland fire governance system. NMAC will evaluate recommendations/requests and provide them to the appropriate governing body through formal correspondence.
