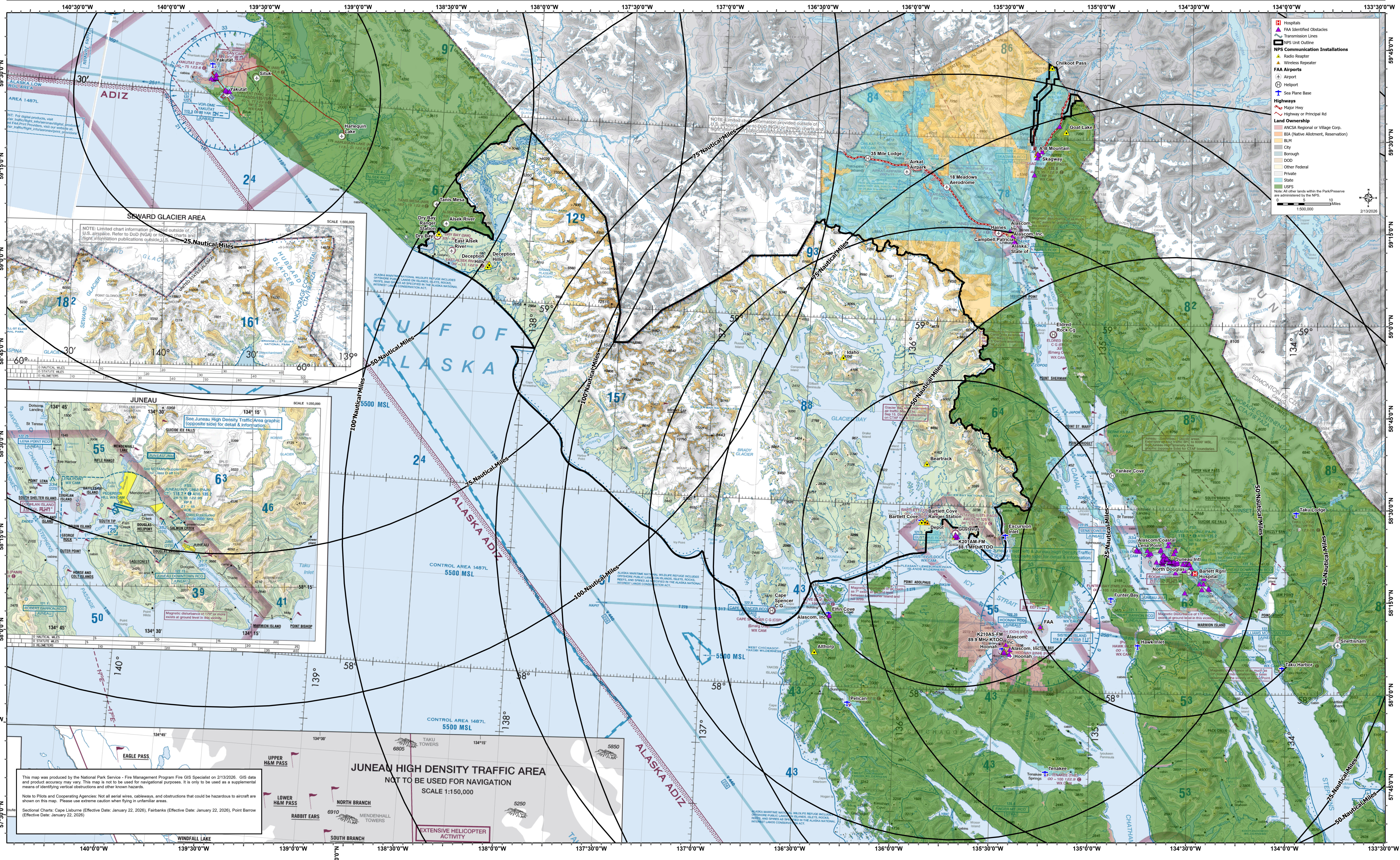


Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve Aerial Hazard Map - Known Aviation Hazards - 2026
