648 PM AKDT Thu Jul 17 2025 Forecast is based on forecast start time of 1900 AKDT on July 17.

DISCUSSION... Warm and drier conditions will continue as high pressure remains over the Interior. The high pressure will begin to break down on Sunday bringing wetting rain chances across much of the Western Interior. Wetting rains will continue into next week, as southwest flow gives us ample moisture from the Bering Sea. Temperatures will be cool down on Saturday, and will continue on a downward trend into next week. Winds will be below 12 mph, and will start out of the east tonight. Friday night we will see a wind shift to southerly. .
